In Memoriam John Minor Conner (85) passed away at CareOne Oradell Rehab Facility on May 19, 2022 following a lengthy hospitalization. Throughout John's life he lived in Kansas City, Los Angeles, Washington DC, New York City, and New Jersey. John devoted his life to music, specifically playing the organ, and was considered a world-class performer by many who knew his work. He played from the age of 13 until he was 84 years old, and played on many amazing organs, retiring only a year before his death. Funeral Services will be held at St. Mary the Virgin Church on June 6, 2022 145 W 46th St, New York, NY 10036 at 10 am. His final resting place will be at Brookside Cemetery in Englewood, NJ.
